The festival will have two stages. Tickets will be \$20 for Saturday night and \$40 for all-day Sunday. Anticipated attendance is 300 on Saturday, and 500 on Sunday.

Proceeds from **"Blues for Schools"** will go to Canby and Wilsonville High School Performing Arts Programs.
